2. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION/THOROUGHBRED RACING RULE, 178 CSR 1
  - A. Amendments to the rule to incorporate the RCI Therapeutic Medication Schedule, Version 1.0 (Adopted April 2, 2013 by RCI).
  - B. Amendments to the rule to adopt the RCI Model Rule requiring Lasix to be administered by a veterinarian or veterinarians designated/appointed by the Racing Commission.
  - C. Amendments to the rule to require the Racing Commission's primary testing laboratory and laboratories conducting split sample testing to be accredited by the Racing Medication Testing Consortium (RMTC).
  - D. Amendments to § 48.4.c. of the rule to add additional substances to the prohibition against the use and/or possession of blood doping agents to conform to the current RCI Model Rule.
  - E. Amendments to the Uniform Classification Guidelines for Foreign Substances (currently Table D in the Thoroughbred Racing Rule, 178 CSR 1), to conform with the current version of the Guidelines (Version 5.00) published by RCI.
  - F. Amendments to §§ 23.1.e. and 24.4.b. of the rule to conform with the 2013 legislative amendment to § 24.1.i., which allows the children and grandchildren of certain licensed permit holders to obtain a permit at age sixteen.
  - G. Amendments to the rule to require the stewards to have a hearing upon receiving a written complaint against a racing official – Erich Zimny
  - H. Amendments to the rule to void/reverse a claim on a horse if the horse breaks down – Dr. Beth Albrecht
