

**West Virginia Racing Commission
Administration of Procaine Penicillin Report**

Any trainer with a horse having received procaine penicillin within 30 days of entry must submit this form. The form is to be submitted to the WV Racing Commission veterinarian or stewards on the day of entry. Procaine penicillin shall not be administered to the horse from the day of entry through the race. The horse is required to be under surveillance for a minimum of 6 hours prior to post time of the race at a designated area on the racing association grounds. The owner is responsible for all expenses associated with the surveillance. (Rule 49.9)
